

## August Block of the Month

Finished size: 14 1/2" x 9 1/2"

Fabrics: Fat Quarters of Background – Sky Blue

Pickup – solid color (red, yellow, blue, green or any bold color)

Scraps for remaining parts of block

Cut from Sky Blue: 2 1/2" x 14 1/2", 2 1/2" x 6 1/2", 2 1/2" x 7 1/2",  
2 1/4" x 3 1/2", a 1" square and two 1 1/2" x 1" pieces

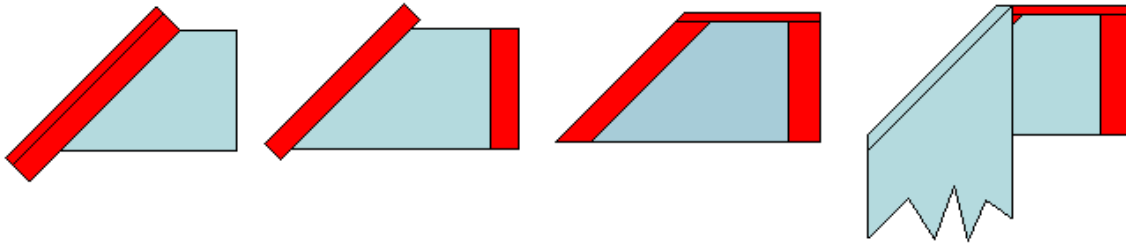
Cut from Pickup fabric: 3 1/2" x 12 1/2", 1" x 2 1/4", 3/4" x 4"  
3/4" x 3", two 1" squares and two 2" circles

Brown scrap: 2 1/2" x 14 1/2"

Black scrap: two 5" circles

Green foliage scrap: two 2 1/2" x 1 1/2" and two 1" squares

Cut one end of the 2 1/4" x 3 1/2" sky blue piece at 45°. Sew the 3/4" x 4" strip of red on the diagonal end and the 1" x 2 1/4" red strip on the opposite end. Trim to fit. Sew the 3/4" x 3" red strip on the top of the window. Now cut the 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" sky blue piece at 45° and sew it to the front of the window. Sew the 2 1/2" x 7 1/2" piece of sky blue to the back of the window. The hardest part is finished.



Snowball the hood of the pickup as seen in diagram. Sew together the two bumper sections and add them to ends of the pickup body. Sew the remaining strip of sky to the top of the window section. Add the pickup body section below the window, and finally sew the roadway to the bottom.

Baste the red circle to the middle of the black circle. Folding edges forward 1/4" on black circle make a large running stitch around edge. Gather to center to make a yo-yo. Tack to pickup as shown.
