



## We All Scream for Ice Cream

Basket Bonanza Quilt of the Month, August 2007

51.5" x 57.5"

### For the quilt top you will need:

- 15 nine inch Sugar Bowl blocks  
(see CBQ August 2007 BOM instructions)
- One and a half yards of 40 inch wide screaming yellow solid cotton fabric, or color of your choice.

### Cutting

Rotary cut the following lengthwise strips of solid fabric:

- Four 6.5" x 45.5" strips
- Two 6.5" x 51.5" strips

### Piecing

1. Sew the basket blocks into three vertical rows with five blocks each, alternating their direction as shown in the diagram above.
2. Sew the four 45.5" solid strips to the three vertical block rows, alternating solid strips and vertical rows of blocks, beginning and ending with a solid strip.
3. Sew one 51.1" solid strip to the top and one to the bottom.

### Finishing

- Layer the quilt with batting and backing.
- Quilt in the ditch around the basket pieces and quilt something fun in the solid sections.
- Bind, add a label on the back, and enjoy!
