

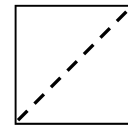

medium and dark*

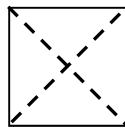
**CUTTING DIRECTIONS:**

1. (A) Background: Cut two  $3 \frac{7}{8} \times 3 \frac{7}{8}$ , then cut in half

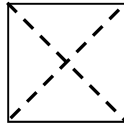


diagonally.

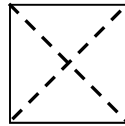
2. (B) Background: Cut one square  $7 \frac{1}{4} \times 7 \frac{1}{4}$ .



3. (B) Red: Cut 1 square  $7 \frac{1}{4} \times 7 \frac{1}{4}$ .



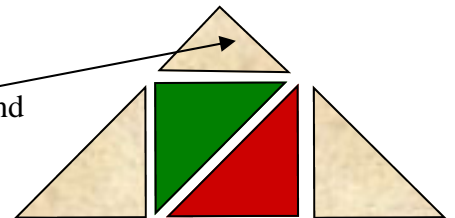
4. (B) Green: Cut one square  $7 \frac{1}{4} \times 7 \frac{1}{4}$ .



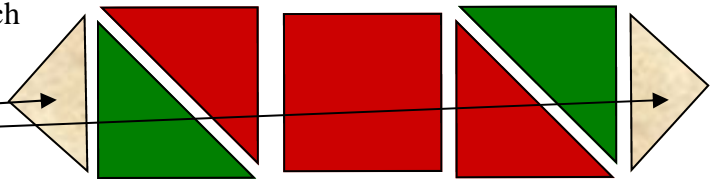
5. (C) Cut one square  $4 \frac{3}{4} \times 4 \frac{3}{4}$ , fussy cut OR red (center block).

**SEWING DIRECTIONS:**

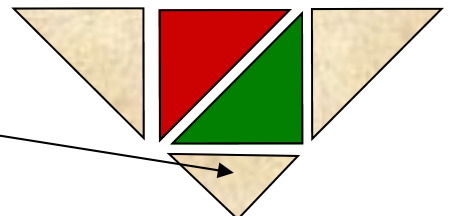
Row 1: Sew red and green  $\frac{1}{2}$  square triangles together. Add background on each side. Add A background to top corner.



Row 2: Sew Red and green triangles together on each side of center block, add a corner background A on each side of center. Add a corner A to each red and green B.



Row 3: Sew a B red and green together, add a background B to each side. Add a corner A to end.



Sew rows 1 to 2 & 3. Press each row in opposite directions as you sew together.
