

June Block of the Month

Finished size: 9 1/2" square

Fabrics: Fat Quarters of Background – Sky Blue

Scraps for remaining parts of block

Cut from Sky Blue: Four 1 3/8" squares to snowball the corners of the Stop sign

1 1/2" strip to go on all four sides of stop sign

Green foliage scrap: 3 1/2" strip

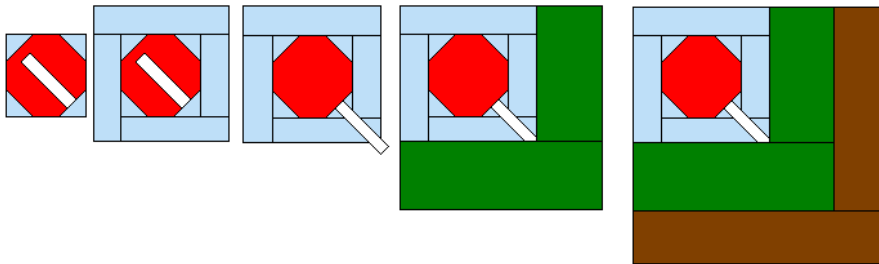
Brown scrap: 2 1/2" strip

Solid Red Scrap: 3" square

White scrap: 3" x 1 1/4" strip

Sew white scrap lengthwise to make a tube. Finger press seam allowance open then turn so seam allowance is inside. Center one end of white piece on one side of red square. Snowball all four corners of stop sign with the blue squares. Sew blue strip all around the stop sign.

Flip the white sign post down over the blue, tack in place, and then sew the green strip on both sides of sign post. Now sew brown road way strips to the green foliage.



Tree trunk spacer blocks:

Finished size: 9 1/2" x 8"

Fabrics: Sky Blue: 4 1/2" x 3 1/2"

Brown tree trunk fabric: 2" x 4 1/2"

Green foliage: 3 1/2" x 8"

Brown roadway: 2 1/2" x 8"

Sew blue strips on both sides of brown strip. Add green and brown strips to the bottom to make the tree trunk spacers.

Plain Spacer blocks:

Finished size: 9 1/2" by width of fabric

Fabrics: Sky Blue: 4 1/2" by width of fabric

Green foliage: 3 1/2" by width of fabric

Brown roadway: 2 1/2" by width of fabric

Sew strips together and cut to desired width for spaces between vehicles.
