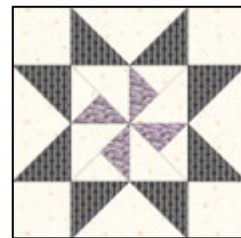

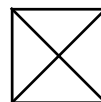

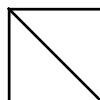
### CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

A: Color 1: Cut (4)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

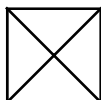
B: Color 1: Cut (1)  $7\frac{1}{4}$ " x  $7\frac{1}{4}$ " square and then cut diagonally both ways.  
Set 4 aside.



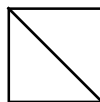
C, Color 1: Cut (2)  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " Then cut once diagonally.



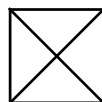
D. Color 1: Cut (1)  $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{4}$ " into.



C. Color 2: Cut (4)  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x  $3\frac{7}{8}$ ", then cut once diagonally.



D. Color 2: Cut (1)  $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{4}$ " diagonally both ways.

### SEWING INSTRUCTIONS:

A. Sew pairs of quarter triangles together of Color 1 & 2 right sides together.

B. Add the color 2 half square triangle.

Sew the units together to form one pinwheel.

Next sew C. 1/2 square triangle of Color 2 to B of Color 1. Make 4 units.

Sew the blocks together using the corner squares, the flying geese units and the center pinwheel. Press rows alternating.
