

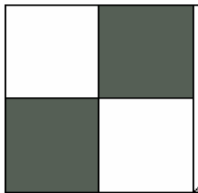
MILKY WAY

Cutting instructions:

Layer right sides together

(2) 3" squares light (1) 1 3/4 x 36" strip light (1) 7" x 10 1/2" light

(3) 3" squares medium (1) 1 3/4" x 36" strip dark (1) 7" x 10 1/2" medium

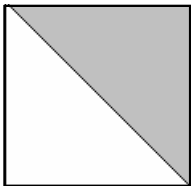
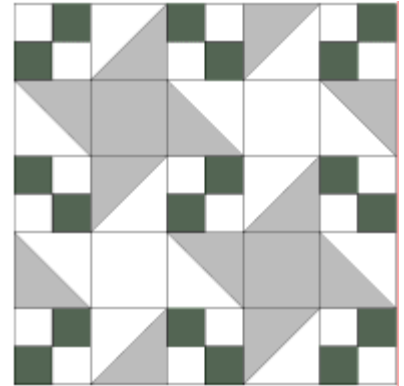


Making 9 four patch.

Sew the 1 3/4" strips of light and dark together.
Cut into (18) 1 3/4" sections.

Make two stacks with nine in each.

Assembly line sew them together in this order.



Making the twelve.

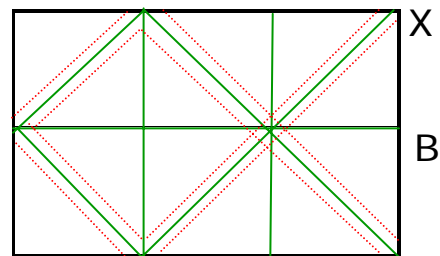
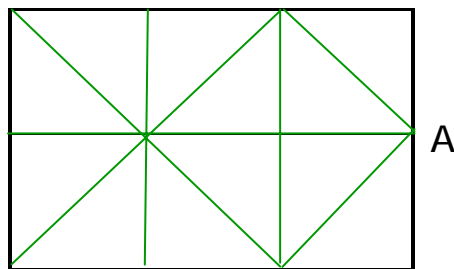
Place the 7 x 10 1/2 pieces of light and medium right sides together on a gridded board.

Draw on 3 1/2 inch squares lines (A).

Draw on diagonal lines every other row beginning in the marked corner (A).

Draw on diagonal lines in the remaining rows in the opposite direction (A).

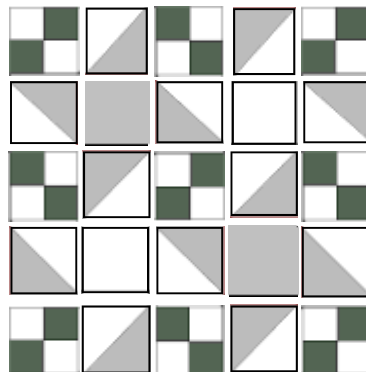
Flip the piece around and starting at the x, sew a 1/4 inch seam on BOTH sides of the diagonal lines. (B) Cut apart on the 3 1/2 square lines and diagonal lines. Press the seams to the dark side. Trim off the tips. Approximate size: 3", square up as needed.



Sewing the block together

Lay all pieces out in this order.

Square to 12 1/2" unfinished.



Christmas year round sampler quilt.

6 fabrics: 3/4 yds of each light, medium and dark in Christmas colors.
