

# October Block of the Month

Finished size: 14 1/4" x 10 1/2"

Fabrics: Background – Sky Blue

Truck – your choice of color

Cut from Sky Blue: 2 1/2" x 14 1/4", 2 1/2" x 3 1/4", 1 1/2" x 2 1/8", 1 1/2" x 4", 2" x 3 1/2", 1 1/2" x 1", and a 1" square

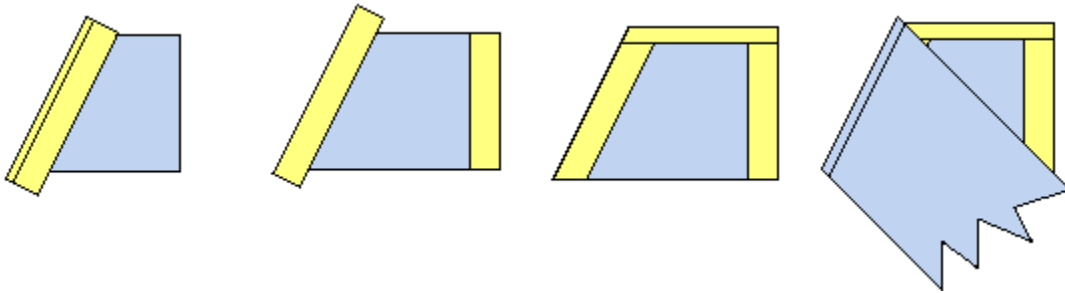
Cut from Truck fabric: 5" square for bottom of truck cab, 6 1/2" x 8" for the back of truck, 1" x 2 1/4", 3/4" x 3 1/2", 3/4" x 3", two 1" squares and two 2" circles

Brown scrap: 2 1/2" x 14 1/4"

Black scrap: two 4 1/2" to 5" circles

Green foliage scrap: two 2 1/2" x 1 1/2" and two 1" squares

Cut one end of the 2" x 3 1/2" sky blue piece at 60°. Sew the 3/4" x 3 1/2" strip of yellow on the diagonal end and the 1" x 2" yellow strip on the opposite end. Trim to fit. Sew the 3/4" x 3" yellow strip on the top of the window. Now cut one end of the 2 1/2" x 3 1/4" sky blue piece at 60° and sew it to the front of the window.



Snowball the hood of the bakery truck as seen in diagram. Sew together the two bumper sections and add the short one to the cab front. Join the truck cab section below the window section, add the truck back, then add the rear bumper section to the box. Sew the remaining strip of sky on the top of the block, and, sew the roadway to the bottom.

Baste the yellow fabric circles to the middle of the black circles. Folding edges forward 1/4" on black circle make a large running stitch around edge. Gather to center to make a yo-yo. Tack yo-yo wheels to your delivery van as shown. Embellish as desired.
