

# BLOCK of the Month: Let's go...To the Museum with Positive/Negative Blocks

**COLORS:**                **RED** or **YELLOW** or **BLUE**    **AND**    **WHITE**

**CUTTING** for one pair of 8 ½" unfinished blocks:

<b>RED</b> or <b>YELLOW</b> or <b>BLUE</b>	(1) 4 ½" x 4 ½"	(2) 2 ½" x 4 ½"	(2) 2 ½" x 8 ½"
<b>WHITE</b>	(1) 4 ½" x 4 ½"	(2) 2 ½" x 4 ½"	(2) 2 ½" x 8 ½"

**SEWING:** You will be making two blocks: One with **RED** or **YELLOW** or **BLUE** in the center, surrounded by **WHITE**, the other with **WHITE** in the center, surrounded by **RED** or **YELLOW** or **BLUE**. Sew 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips to opposite sides of 4 ½" square, right sides together, as per diagram. Press toward dark. Sew 2 ½" x 8 ½" strips to opposite sides of 4 ½" x 8 ½" set, right sides together, as per diagram. Press toward dark. Each pair of blocks is made from one **RED** or **YELLOW** or **BLUE** and one **WHITE**.

Use one **RED** or **YELLOW** or **BLUE** and one **WHITE** in each pair of blocks to make these bright and fresh blocks. Strong, bright **RED** or **YELLOW** or **BLUE** pair best with **WHITE**. You may use any prints or solids for any of the colors. Easy blocks are so fun to make! How many pair will you create?
