

BLOCK of the Month: Let's go...To the Farm with Shoefly Blocks

COLORS: **FRUIT or VEGETABLE PRINTS** with **OFF-WHITE/BEIGE** background

CUTTING for 12 ½" unfinished block:

FRUIT/VEG (2) 5" x 5" (1) 4 ½" x 4 ½" **OFF-WHITE/BEIGE** (2) 5" x 5" (4) 4 ½" x 4 ½"

CUTTING for 6 ½" unfinished block:

FRUIT/VEG (2) 3" x 3" (1) 2 ½" x 2 ½" **OFF-WHITE/BEIGE** (2) 3" x 3" (4) 2 ½" x 2 ½"

SEWING: This is a Shoefly block. Draw a diagonal line, corner to corner, across back of each **OFF-WHITE** 5" (or 3") square. Place right sides together with **FRUIT/VEG** 5" (or 3") square. Sew a line ¼" on either side of diagonal. Cut on drawn line, press towards **FRUIT/VEG** and trim to 4 ½" (or 2 ½"). Assemble block as per diagram with remaining 4 ½" (or 2 ½") squares of **OFF-WHITE** and **FRUIT/VEG**.

Use one **FRUIT** or **VEGETABLE** print in each block along with any **OFF-WHITE/BEIGE** for your background to make these blocks ready for harvest! You can make just 12 ½" blocks or just 6 ½" blocks or both.
